While volunteering, you also get the opportunity to connect personally with the campers, learning everything from their interests and hobbies, to the best way to help them get into bed at night.



There is nothing better than seeing the smile on a camper's face when a counselor takes the time to get to know him, or hearing a camper say that she wants to work at camp because she is having so much fun. Camp also lets you connect and make life-long friends with people who have a passion for giving of themselves. It gets to be like a family, where everyone works closely together to ensure campers' needs are met in a fun and safe way.

We are always looking for people to volunteer for our weekend programs at both Camp Wawbeek and Respite Camp in Wisconsin Dells. We provide on-site room and board, as well as a brief training period. Volunteers are needed by Friday at 3:00 pm for training; the camp session lasts until Sunday at 4:00 pm. We do ask you to fill out an application and submit a reference form. After we receive these items, we will do a background check and interview you. You must be at least age 18 to provide direct camper care. Camp Events throughout the Year:

Easter Seals Wisconsin camps are home to many events throughout the year. From camp clean-ups to fundraisers, volunteers play a critical role in the success of each event. Here are some of the events that take place during the year for which volunteers are needed:



MLK Day of Service: This takes place every Martin Luther King, Jr. Day (third Monday of January) in honor of the spirit behind this great man. Help with creating items for campers to use and repairs around camp.

Winter Warm-Up: This spring fundraiser takes place at a restaurant in the Wisconsin Dells. Volunteers are needed to help with raffles and other various tasks that help the event run smoothly.



Spring Camp Work Day: Generally taking place the second Saturday in May, come help get camp ready for another summer season. General help is needed along with skilled labor.

Fall Sprawl: This 5K Run, Walk or Roll takes place the first Saturday in October and helps raise money for camp. Volunteers are needed for a variety of tasks, such as helping with registration, raffles and managing water stations.



Pancake Breakfast: This event takes place the first Sunday of October to raise money for camp. Help is needed flipping pancakes and assisting with serving breakfast that morning.

Fall Camp Make A Difference Day: Taking place on a Saturday during October, volunteers help prepare camp for the winter. General help is needed along with skilled labor.



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
